The Gueguen family lives in Préhy, about 7 km south-west of Chablis. This winery is young, established in January of 2013 by both Céline and Frédéric whom had preivously been working for larger wine estates in Chablis over the course of 15 years. The Gueguen's are passionate about conservation and respect towards the environment, aiming to create a wine representative of its terroir. Finally, they love sharing their knowledge and estate with their visitors, and have even set up their own Bed and Breakfast.

Between the Auxerrois and Chablisien vineyards, the estate of C»line and Fr»d»ric Gueguen is made up of 23 hectares of vines in the villages of Chablis, Chich»e, la Chapelle Vaupelteigne, Saint-Bris and Irancy. C»line comes from a family of winegrowers, originally from Saint Bris le Vineux.

For 15 years, I have been wine-maker in two important renowned domaine in Chablis (Domaine Durup & Domaine Brocard). However, my best wish was to work for myself, so I could understand my wines from the vineyard to the bottle.
