## Precision and Purity of Flavor

Von Schleinitz is a 12 ha vineyard in Mosel, Germany planted to 80% Riesling, 10% Pinot Noir, 5% Pinot Blanc, 2% Pinot Gris, 3% Dornfelder, Regent, Pinot Noir Precoce.

Created at Von Schleinitz by Konrad Hähn, High Def is the value line from the esteemed winery. The Hähn family traces its winemaking roots to 1648. Konrad is the third-generation owner of Von Schleinitz and took over from his father, Karlheinz who bought Freiherr von Schleinitz in 1956 and merged it with his father Peter's estate, keeping the VS name. Peter Hähn settled in Koblenz and started the winery in 1892.

Konrad Hähn places great importance on organic and sustainable agriculture as well as reductive winemaking. The wines are handcrafted using meticulous fruit selection maximizing the soil reflection especially in the grand cru vineyards Uhlen and Weissenberg.

The winery is located in the Terrassen-Mosel, the most northern part of the Mosel valley. It is the warmest area within the Mosel appellation and the second warmest area in Germany (after Kaiserstuhl, Baden). This warm micro-climate and the use of terraces along the south-facing slopes allows the vines to grow to full ripeness despite the northern location.

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
