From very small and modest beginnings when Hermann and Agnes grafted the vines late into the night, to today when all three Seifried children have returned home to play their part in growing the family business. Seifried Estate is a company devoted to sustainable wine-growing and producing the very best Nelson has to offer.

Pure, varietal and sustainably produced wines is Seifried Estate's focus. Today Seifried harvest grapes from just over 325 hectares of producing vineyards across ten vineyard locations. Each of the Seifried vineyards are located in the beautiful Nelson region and spread over three main soil types – heavy clay loam, sandy silty coastal sites, and rocky river beds.

New Zealand is a land known for its wide open spaces, natural beauty and innovative people. While a relatively young country, New Zealand's natural environment is something that can't be taken for granted. With this comes the NZ wine industry's commitment to looking after this special slice of paradise.
