



Von Schleinitz

Terroir Driven Wines, Mosel Terraced Slate.

The Hähn family, who owns the Von Schleinitz Estate, can trace their winemaking roots in the Mosel valley as far back as the year 1648. In 1892, Peter Hähn moved to Kobern and started a small winery at the current location. Karlheinz Hähn, grandson of Peter Hähn, expanded the winery by buying the Freiherr von Schleinitz estate and merged the two keeping the von Schleinitz name.

Starting with the 1976 vintage in cooperation with his father Karlheinz Hähn, Konrad began winemaking at Von Schleinitz with one of the greatest vintages of the last century. Today, 40+ vintages later, he has accumulated a vast knowledge in his field from tending to the vines, to sorting and handling of the grapes, to guiding the fermentation and finally to the timing of the release of the wines.

The winery is located in the Terrassen-Mosel, the most northern part of the Mosel valley. It is the warmest area within the Mosel appellation and the second warmest area in Germany (after Kaiserstuhl, Baden). This warm micro-climate and the use of terraces along the south facing slopes allows the vines to grow to full ripeness despite the northern location.

Von Schleinitz is recognized as one of the top 100 estates in Germany.

The high quality of the wines is continuously confirmed by awards and medals received in regional and national as well as international competitions.

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
