



# Bodegas Tridente

Bodegas Tridente is located in Villanueva de Campean, 30km south from Zamora, in the center of the so-called Land of The Wine. The winery, small sized, and designed for small productivity of red grapes, especially those of Tinta de Toro variety, indigenous of the land and with a tradition in the region. Also produced at Tridente is Prieto Picudo and Mencía varieties of grapes, coming from old vineyards with a low productivity, from Bierzo and León regions. The Gil Family is accompanied by Enrique Busto in this project and the technical direction is managed by Frank Gonzales, Australian enologist with a Spanish origin.

The Bodegas Tridente vineyards of Tempranillo grapes are located in the areas of El Pego and Villanueva de Campean within the province of Zamora.

These vineyards are upwards of 130 years old and are planted on sandy soils in the traditional vaso system with very low yields. The grapes are hand-picked then fermented in stainless steel tanks. The grapes are then moved to French oak barrels where fermentation is completed.

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
